

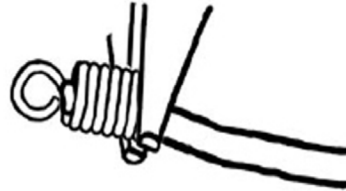
coil crimp technique

Coil crimps can be used with tough, thicker cords like leather.

1. Put a dab of super glue on the cord and slide it all the way into the coil crimp. Let the glue dry for a minute.



2. Use chain-nose pliers to gently squeeze the last revolution of the coil.



- *Be careful - if you squeeze too hard, you may cut through the cord.

3. Keep moving around the last revolution, squeezing gently as you go.



4. Tug gently on the coil crimp to make sure it is firmly attached to the cord.



5. Open the loop like a jump ring, and attach a clasp. Use the same method for the other end of the cord.
