

Sunglass Leash

The bright UV rays of the sun can be very damaging to your eyes and can cause wrinkles.

To protect your eyes and your skin keep your sunglasses close at hand. Make a fun coordinated sunglass leash for every outfit this season!



To be economical try using leftover beads and seed beads from previous projects or search through your bead stash for inspiration. Select a palette of color coordinated or complimentary beads and seed beads to match your new seasonal outfits.

Tools:

- Beading Wire Cutter
- Crimping Tool

Technique:

- Crimp Bead Technique: Crimping Pliers

Materials:

- 36" Flexible Beading Wire (.15)
- 2 sterling silver crimp beads
- 2 Eyeglass Holders
- 1 Czech Glass Bead Mix
- 1 vial size 6 Seed Beads

Instructions:

- String one sterling silver crimp bead and one eyeglass holder on to one end of the 36" flexible beading wire.
- String the loose end of the flexible beading wire back through the sterling silver crimp bead. Crimp the crimp bead using the crimping tool.
- String a random pattern of Czech Glass beads and size 6 seed beads onto the 16" flexible beading wire. Leave 2" of the wire exposed at the end.
- String the other crimp bead and eyeglass holder onto the exposed end of the flexible beading wire.
- String the loose end of the flexible beading wire back through the sterling silver crimp bead. Crimp the crimp bead using the crimping tool.
